

## Crash and Smash

### Protection from Crash and Smash

Subscribers to our 'GoMobile' package get the benefits of our "Crash and Smash" technology. You'll have the benefits of false alarm reduction and can relax knowing that if a "Crash and Smash" attack happens, the central station will be notified immediately.

Most systems have entry and alarm reporting delays to allow you to have time to disarm the system when you enter your home. The system will wait until the end of this delay before reporting an alarm issue. You need this delay to prevent unnecessary false alarms and police deployment.

However, these delays give an intruder time to find and destroy the alarm panel. This is known as a "Crash and Smash" event.

### How do we protect you?

We transmit a special 'entry delay' message to our central station. Our central station is expecting to receive a 'disarm' message. When it does not, it sends a 'possible crash and smash' signal. The central station responds and alerts the police.

This alert also works if the intruder doesn't use a entry delay door and finds another way in. When the security system goes into the alarm state, we transmit a 'Pending Alarm' signal. This can then be converted to an alarm state if the system is not disarmed.

### Asheboro Alarm

#### "CRASH AND SMASH" Scenario

1. Intruder enters home through an entry delay door. Entry delay begins.
2. Intruder listens for entry delay and locates the control panel.
3. Intruder smashes the control panel before the delay expires.
4. Intruder thinks the security system is now disabled and attempts to rob home.
5. Police arrive minutes later and the intruder is arrested.
